**2004 Corison**, "Kronos Vineyard", Napa Valley (\$125) – Medium-dark ruby; cedary, very attractive, intense, dark currant and sweet blackberry fruit aroma with notes of cola and graphite; full body; rich, firmly structured, cassis and dark berry fruit flavors; well balanced; medium-full tannin; lingering aftertaste. Shows very appealing varietal character and should continue to develop with another three to five more years of bottle aging. **Very highly recommended.** 13.8% alcohol; 355 cases; 100% CS; released Fall 2008.
