# 2015 Corison Sunbasket Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon



Heat in the spring set the stage for an early season. Then May turned cold at flowering which resulted in a small crop, made even smaller by the ongoing drought. The resulting scraggly clusters of tiny berries were intensely delicious. Heat in August and September brought the grapes in for one of the earliest harvests on record. Vibrant, fresh and energetic, this wine is sunshine in a bottle. Black-raspberry pastille, boysenberry and raspberry freezer jam jump out of the glass, accompanied by baking spices and cumin. Earth and minerals join violet perfume to lift the aromas, and polished tannins contribute a full, smooth texture.

#### **Top 100 Wines of 2018**

95 Pts Corison 2015 St. Helena Sunbasket Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon

Cathy Corison began working with fruit from the site, just north of her winery on the west side of Highway 29. She purchased the vineyard in 2014. That year, it was the cabernet franc that showed remarkable briskness and cool spice. In 2015, it's the cabernet sauvignon that shines, with that coolness of deep-rooted cabernet harvested at the right time. It's full and lush, the flavors extending into a savory, red-fruited finish, meaty and rich rather than sweet. Its concentration doesn't get in the way of its dynamic energy, which brings out floral notes and cool spice, lasting with gentle grace.

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#### CORISON Sunbasket Vineyard St. Helena 2015

Long a champion of restraint rather than an adherent of ripe and blustery wines, winemaker Cathy Corison has come up with yet another sleek and stylish wine of concise, curranty fruit backed by discreet oak. It lacks for nothing in the way of

substance and structure, and it evokes an ongoing sense of seriousness with the kind of tannic spine to age and last for many years. It is just astringent enough to command waiting and will need a good half-decade of patience before fully unfolding... it exhibits great presence and staying power.

Made from a site planted in the 1950s by the grand wine wizard André Tchelistcheff, this wine is remarkable in its gravelly mineral character and well-managed tannin profile. Soft supple texture is complemented by focused layers of savory red fruit and lifted acidity. Enjoyable now, it has structure to age. Enjoy best 2020-2030.

Decanter Top California Cabernet 2015 Wines

92 Corison's relatively recent purchase of a vineyard she named Sunbasket has deeper fruit aromas and flavours than her estate bottling, yet at just 13.9% alcohol. It shines, with a juicy cherry and blackcurrant core and notes of black olive, forest floor and mint, with judicious oak and lively acidity.

body; rich, ripe, nicely balanced, stylish, bright, red and dark berry fruit flavors with hints of baking spices, supported with vibrant acidity, and finishes with a velvety mouthfeel; full, though well under control tannin; lingering aftertaste. 94 The nose is deeper and denser though maintains elegance of sweet fragrant lavender. The palate is a saturated sweetness of pure fruit, black current, plum skin and violet. Doug Wilder, Issue 7.4



95 The 2015 Sunbasket Cabernet Sauvignon is simply striking. It begins with highly perfumed aromas of currants and blackberries laced with fresh spring florals, graphite and minerals all soaring from the glass. This continues to impress on the palate with its

outstanding structure and beautifully polished tannins, along with a fantastic combination of ripe fruit and fresh acidity. It shows remarkable purity and class as it finishes with lovely finesse. This is a total beauty from Cathy Corison in this vintage. May, 2018

93-94 The nose is fruity, fresh and offers concentration as well as a richness. It reveals notes of cassis, blackberry and small notes of strawberry associated with a discreet hint of black cherry as well as subtle hints of cocoa, sweet spices and an imperceptible hint of

violet. The palate is fruity, fresh, mineral, well-balanced and offers a good definition, an acid frame, minerality, a good volume, fat, suavity, a small concentration as well as roundness. On the palate this wine expresses notes of black cherry, cassis and small notes of blackberry associated with small touches of wild strawberry, ripe juicy redcurrants as well as subtle hints of liquorice, tea, flowers, chocolate and a very discreet touch of blond tobacco.
