## 2020 Helios Sunbasket Vineyard Cabernet Franc



The result of a long and cool ripening season (and oblivious to the Covid chaos swirling around it), the 2020 Cabernet Franc was picked nearly three weeks before the Glass Fire broke out and was safely down to barrels by then. Industrial-grade air filters kept smoke out of the winery, protecting our lovely 2020's.

Intense dried rose petal and lavender perfume jump out of the glass, with bright cherry and brambly raspberry aromas and flavors leading the way. Hints of bacon and baking spices chime in and stony minerality ties it all together. Unity.

## VIEW FROM THE CELLAR 95 The 2020 Cabernet Franc "Sunbasket Vineyard' bottling from Cathy

Corison is a lovely young wine that really shows its varietal character in

this vintage, where it comes in at 13.5 percent octane. The bouquet is gorgeous, wasting from the glass in a mix of black cherries, sweet dark berries, tobacco leaf, dark soil tones, a hint of tree bark, gentle new oak and a smoky topnote. On the palate the wine is pure, full-bodied, focused and complex, with a beautiful core of black fruit, fine soil signature, suave, finegrained tannins, excellent balance and a long, pure and very promising finish. Medium to dark garnet in color, this wine smells of crushed nuts, plum and cherry. In the mouth, juicy and bright flavors of cherry and plum skin mix with pencil lead and dried herbs. Excellent acidity keeps things juicy, as limber, athletic tannins embrace the palate. Elegant. 13.5% alcohol. Score: between 9 and 9.5.

94 The 2020 Helios Sunbasket Vineyard' Cabernet Franc is one of the great wines of its kind that I have tasted from this vintage. 93 The 2020 'Helios' Sunbasket Vineyard Cabernet Franc is a wonderful showing in this vintage. It seems the warmth from the vintage has amped up the volume a bit, resulting in a touch more opulence than previous releases, yet still retaining its elegance and freshness. 93 The nose is fresh tar and sweet baking spice with notes of dried plum and dark cherry. The palate entry is densely-packed herb, black plum and sleek nectarine in the core finishing with textured blossom and soaked cherry. Beautiful balance.
