## 2020 Corison Sunbasket Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon



The result of a nearly perfect season (and oblivious to the pandemic), the 2020 was picked and in the barn nearly three weeks before the Glass Fire broke out. Filters kept the air fresh in the winery as the wines went down to barrels. We are so grateful to present this lovely wine.

Signature intense raspberry fruit and grace notes of tart cherry, plum and currants are singing here. The cool ripening season promoted inky color and snappy balance. A haunting perfume of rose petals and violets is striking in the aromas, while a pulse of slate minerality completes the picture.

## Decanter

**96** Cathy Corison's newest single-vineyard designate from Sunbasket Vineyard in St. Helena AVA, aged 20 months in 50% new French oak, shows the prowess of excellent winemaking. This tightly knit Cabernet is the iron fist in the velvet glove with lofty red-toned mineral aromatics

atop cherry and black currant notes. At the same time, the palate is fresh and alive, sporting a linear quality that draws a straight line from the red- and black-toned fruit profile to the cedar-rich elegant, fine-grained tannins to the dried wild herb finish. This is a tightly-knit, masterful creation from the 2020 vintage and should be enjoyed now and often over the next 5-7 years, possibly longer.

**93+** Suave and plush, the Sunbasket has more than enough fruit to balance the tannins in this vintage. Dark red cherry, red plum, coffee, herbs and dried rose petals all meld together effortlessly. The 2020 is exuberant and quite flashy, with all the elements very nicely balanced. This is a gorgeous wine, with a ton of potential. The purity of the fruit here is just striking.

98 With grip and intensity, this wine opens in strong notions of savory sage, spice and stone-like granite. The fruit is high-toned and tart, a mix of cherry and currant that emphasize the wine's underlying acidity, while texture and length build on the

**94** Shows lovely focus and purity, with a stream of hibiscus and iris notes leading the way for slightly taut red currant, damson plum and red cherry coulis flavors. **94** The 2020 Cabernet Sauvignon Sunbasket Vineyard is classic Corison in style, offering up restrained black cherries and hints of pencil shavings with gentle herbal nuances. The Sunbasket is still just medium-bodied, but it seems a bit fuller than the regular bottling, showing more richness and tannins, at least, with a long, mouthwatering yet velvety finish.

95 The single-varietal 2020 Sunbasket Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon is deep garnet-purple in color. Notes of blackcurrant jelly, Morello cherries, and mulberries give way to nuances of lilacs, underbrush, and cracked black pepper. The medium-bodied palate is coated with vivacious black fruit flavors with herbal and savory accents and nice grainy tannins, finishing with bags of brightness and energy.
