



These 60 year-old dry-farmed vines grow on their own roots in limestone and granite sand. Floral perfume of jasmine and honeysuckle play with notes of honey and apricot, contributed by beautiful Botrytis (noble rot) on the grapes. Pear and peach fruit fill out the flavors, and the round, plush mouth-feel is in counterpoint with snappy natural acidity. Its balance and dry finish cry out for food.

Corazón is the ancestral form of my family name and means "heart" in Spanish.
