

2022 Corison Kronos Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon



The weather in August, the critical window for wine quality, was nearly perfect in 2022, with long, cool days and nighttime temperatures dipping as low as the chilly 40F's. We started picking Cabernet Sauvignon on 31 August and were mostly finished harvesting when intense heat began around Labor Day. The result was a small harvest of tiny, delicious berries.

Classic Kronos Vineyard, the 2022 is juicy and mineral, sporting kaleidoscopic complexity. Aromas of dark fruit and baking spices join fresh thyme, mint and sage, complexing a pretty floral perfume of violets and lavender, with notes of cacao. Brooding blueberry, plum, boysenberry, and cassis fruit complement cinnamon, nutmeg and clove. Lush, velvety, and mouth-coating, it is weighty without being heavy, showing a quiet richness.

18+ Medium vibrant purple. Wafting aromas of plum and a vein of fresh leafiness. Darker fruit than red... Brooding, concentrated fruit. Fine tannin that builds and complements the high, fresh acidity. Slight mintiness to the finish.

97 The 2022 Kronos Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon is yet another masterful creation from Cathy Corison, showcasing the elegance and balance that have become her signature. The wine opens with captivating aromatics of ripe black currants and blackberries along with crushed violets, graphite, gravel, tobacco and a faint touch of licorice as each swirl of the glass reveals new layers of complexity and depth. On the palate, the wine is vibrant and impeccably pure, displaying remarkable focus, precision, and a graceful sense of energy. The core of luscious red and dark fruit is beautifully framed by refined, polished tannins that lend both texture and structure. Notes of mineral and spice carry through to a long, persistent finish that lingers with elegance and poise. While this Cabernet is already showing impressive character and undeniable charm in its youth, it is clear that it will continue to evolve beautifully over the next decade or more. Patient collectors will be rewarded with a wine that is expressive, beautifully crafted and speaks to both place and precision.

98 Intriguing aromatics evoke Earl Grey tea laced with vanilla and hints of fresh cedar. The tannins are elongated, firm, and taut with a mineral-scented quality that builds with skyscraper-like intensity on the finish, delivering remarkable length and uplift. One of the few 2022 Napa

Cabs with the structure and complexity to cellar for multiple decades. A multidimensional and utterly captivating wine. The winery, a Napa Valley staple since its founding in 1987, has delivered a polished, elegant, and expressive wine in 2022 that defies the heat of the vintage.

95 The 2022 Cabernet Sauvignon Kronos Vineyard is a baby. Aromatic and light on its feet, it is only showing a bit of its potential today... Bright acids and beams of tannin shape this persistent, wonderfully classy St. Helena Cabernet Sauvignon. *Antonio Galloni, Vinous, December 2024*



Dark garnet in the glass, this wine smells of blackcurrant, black cherry, black plum, and a hint of black pepper. In the mouth, gorgeous blackcurrant and licorice root flavors mix with what tastes like a hint of black peppercorn but without the spicy quality. Aromatic and mysterious, with lightly grippy tannins that stay supple with time and fantastic acidity. Score: around **9.5**.

95 The 2022 Cabernet Sauvignon Kronos Vineyard is made from 100% Cabernet Sauvignon. Deep garnet-purple colored, it prances out with classic cassis and juicy plum scents, opening out to suggestions of forest floor, camphor, potpourri, and cardamom. Medium- to full-

bodied, the palate is plush, plump, and juicy with magic tension and a great intensity of cassis and minty flavors, finishing with great length.

96 This wine offers ripe blackberries, wild berries, black olives, wet stones and hints of spices and bay leaves. Full-bodied and compact, with very fine yet tightly wound tannins carrying a juicy core of fruit. The finish is firm but bright and precise. It offers

94 Cathy Corison's 2022 Kronos Vineyard bottling of cabernet sauvignon is an utterly brilliant young wine. It is a fairly ripe vintage for Kronos... but is seamlessly balanced and very elegant in profile nonetheless. The wine's bouquet is a suave and youthful blend of red and black cherries, cigar wrapper, a lovely base of Rutherford soil tones, dark chocolate and a very elegant framing of new oak. On the palate the wine is pure, full-bodied, focused and refined in profile, with a beautiful core of fruit, lovely soil inflection and grip, fine-grained tannins and a long, nascently complex and beautifully balanced finish... she has managed to keep this wine very well balanced, pure and vibrant, despite the heat spikes of 2022.

JEB DUNNUCK

93 Another incredibly successful 2022, the 2022 Cabernet Sauvignon Kronos Vineyard is 100% Cabernet Sauvignon aged 20 months in 50% new French oak. Deep purple/plum-hued, it shows sweet cassis, assorted red and black berries, spring flowers, incense, and spicy wood-driven aromatics. Medium to full-bodied, nicely textured, balanced, and elegant on the palate, it has the forward, slightly more front end-loaded style of the vintage yet solid mid-palate depth and ripe tannins. It's accessible today and should evolve gracefully over the coming 10-12 years, probably longer.
