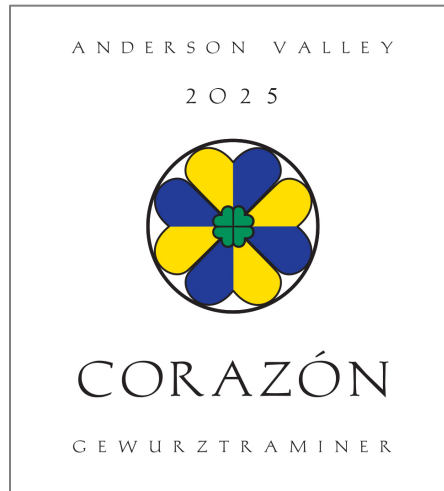




Sourced from the 50-year-old Valley Foothills Vineyard in the Anderson Valley and inspired by the wines of Alsace, this totally dry Gewürztraminer offers aromas of jasmine and lychee, layered with notes of grapefruit zest, white pepper, and ginger spice. A rich, mouth-coating texture fills the palate, balanced by bright natural acidity and a long, dry finish. Made in this style, Gewürztraminer is a perfect companion for food.

Corazón is the ancestral form of our family name and means "heart" in Spanish.
